What we've been up to...

Our topic this term is WW2 and lots of what we have been learning has been based on this. In English we read *Flossie's War* by Marcia Williams and created a page in the style of her work. We also wrote letters from the perspective of an evacuee and poems based on the sights and sounds of war.

We all made a clay 'Remembrance' poppy and used batik to make a school wall hanging for Remembrance Day. We're going to leave the wall hanging in school which can be put up each November to remember those who died in the wars.



In maths we've worked on place value involving 6 figure numbers as well as fractions. We've had to learn the maths in a certain order so once we'd learned one new skill we could then move onto the next e.g. factors of a number, prime factors and finding the lowest common denominator to compare the size of fractions. We've really been using our growth mindset which is great.
