Our topic this term is WW2 and lots of what we have been learning has been based on this. In English we read *Flossie's War* by Marcia Williams; we created a page in the style of her work and wrote letters from the perspective of an evacuee. We also focused on the picture book *Rose Blanche* by Christophe Gallaz and Roberto Innocenti – it took us on a story, during WW2, from a German girls perspective.

We had a great day with 'History off the page' where we went back to the 1940s and what the home-front was like during WW2. We spent the morning in a school room – learning all about what school was like back in those days, then the afternoon was spent in a role play market with tasks to work on. A great day was had by all.



In art we've worked on perspective in pictures and working on our ability to make our drawings look 3D. Science we learned all about light and completed a range of experiments that focussed on reflection and refraction plus we made periscopes.
