In **Computing** we will be learning...

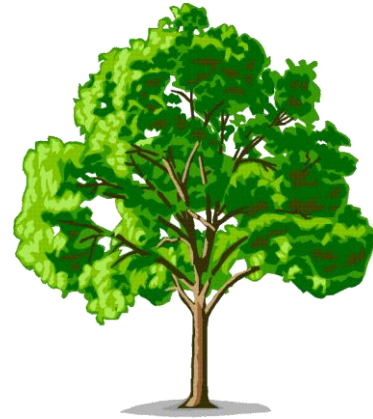
- what desktop publishing is and how we can use it effectively

In **French** we will be learning...

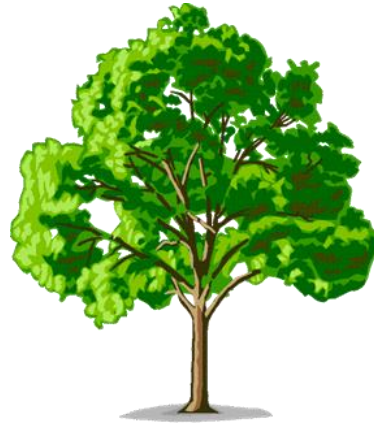
- how to talk about our families
