In English we will be...

- Use a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'l'
- Use the coordinating conjunction 'and'
- Use question marks , use exclamation marks
- To know what a noun is
- Text organisation
- Write complete stories with a simple structure (beginning, middle, end)

In Science we will be learning...

- To identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets).

In **Computing** we will be learning...

- Digital Writing: To use a computer to write.
- **Grouping Data**: Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

In PSHE we will be learning...

- About different emotions and will be using our new Jigsaw PSHE scheme to help us to do this
- About different activities and people who can help us when we don't feel good

In Mathematics we will be learning...

- Place Value within 20
- Addition and subtraction within 20

In P.E. we will be learning...

- to use a range of equipment and apparatus to develop spatial awareness, gross motor skills and throwing and catching skills.
- Our PE lessons will be every Tuesday and Wednesday.

In Art we will be learning...

In Music we will be learning...


- BBC Ten Pieces Peter and the Wolf by Sergei Prokofiev
